Shri. Mohan Bhagwat in our campus

While presiding over a book release function written by Dr. Khwaja Iftekhar, former adviser to Prime Minister of India, Shri P.V Narsimha Rao, Shri Mohan Bhagwat made a strong pitch for religious harmony and said there cannot be any dominance of either Hindus or Muslims in a democracy like India and stated that the DNA of all the countrymen of India is not different for anyone. Shri Bhagwat asserted Hindu – Muslim are one and the base of it is our motherland. We cannot be separated on the basis of our methods of worshiping.



The time has arrived when we have to forget our differences-linguistic, regional and such other factors and be united so that we succeed in our goal of making our beloved country as 'Vishva Guru'. He was emphatic that only if India becomes Vishva Guru, then only world will be a better and safe place to live in.

He went on to add that anybody who does not wish Muslims to live here, is not a real Hindu. He further said that development in the country is not possible without unity, the basis of which should be nationalism and glory of ancestors. While beginning his speech, Shri Bhagwat said he was attending the event neither for any image makeover nor for vote bank politics. He was very categorical that RSS is

committed to nation's welfare. Politics

is not for the volunteers. The sangh does the job of bringing people together whereas politics acts as a instrument for creating differences between people. He said Hindu and Muslims are not able to present an united picture because of politics only. The main aim of RSS is to work for the nation and take it to greater heights. Shri Mohan Bhagwat is the sixth Sarsanghchalak of the Rashtriya Swayamsevak Sangh. Shri Bhagwat has been particular about reaching out to wider public. In 2017, the state-run Animal and Fishery Sciences University awarded Mohan Bhagwat with an honorary doctor of science (DSc) degree during its convocation ceremony in Nagpur.


Placement
