

Bar Council of India has accorded its approval for both the Law courses and National Council for Teacher Education has approved the B.Ed. & D.El.Ed. programme. Both the Institutes are recognized by UGC under section 2(f).

Mewar is committed to develop the potential and skills in each student in a manner that they can face the challenges and get success in all their endeavors. With its fusion of sterling stock of human and capital resources, tradition and modernity, perennial values of life and innovation, heritage and modernity, Mewar looks forward to a path breaking role in the world of education by nurturing learners into practitioners. 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The comfortable location of the Institute at Vasundhara, makes it conveniently accessible through all means of public transport as metro, buses and now the Rapid Rail.

A large and compact campus has three blocks of imposing four-storied buildings. There are spacious lecture rooms, Seminar halls, auditorium, libraries, computer labs and audio visual labs and a PDP lab with mirror room.

The campus also provides extensive open space, eco-friendly and well-maintained lush green areas with aesthetic landscaping. It presents an ideal ambience for a centre of learning.

### Faculty Members

For every good institute the most vital element for a strong foundation is the faculty members. At Mewar the faculty members conduct classes and provide instructions to the students in their respective fields of expertise, develop curriculum, design lesson plans, and assess students' progress through continuous assignments, exams, and projects.

The faculty members serve as mentors and advisors to students, providing guidance and support regarding academic and career choices. They assist students in pursuing internships and trainings related to their fields of study. They are also counselors who bond with the students to mentor them and guide them efficiently. They engage in continuous learning to stay updated with the latest advancements in their fields. They attend conferences, workshops, and training programs to enhance their knowledge and teaching skills. This allows them to provide high-quality education and remain at the forefront of their disciplines.

Faculty members contribute to the overall development and growth of the institute. They participate in the Disciplinary committees,

collaborate in institutional initiatives, and contribute to policy-making decisions. Their involvement helps shape the institute's vision, mission and goals and guide in a strategic direction.

### Teaching Aids and Methodology

At Mewar we have approaches and techniques used by educators to facilitate learning and instruction. It encompasses various instructional methods and techniques for delivering content, classroom management strategies, and assessment practices. Effective teaching methodologies aim to engage students, promote active learning, and enhance their understanding and retention of information.

The class-rooms are spacious, well lit, well ventilated and accommodated with comfortable seating arrangements to facilitate proper teacher-student interaction. For better teaching learning experience classrooms are equipped with LCD Projectors.

In addition to theory classes, inter-class presentations along with chart preparation and assignments on the topics relevant to the course curriculum are frequently organized for the enhancement of knowledge. Each student is allotted a topic after the completion of each unit to prepare presentations and participate in self learning opportunities. By this participatory method of learning the students not only develop confidence to express themselves without any hesitation but also develop in-depth knowledge on the given topics.

The institute also provides “Study Material” and “Question Banks” for each subject prescribed by the University. Industrial Visits, Internship Programs, Guest Lectures further strengthen the theoretical concepts of academics with the professional world. Value Added Courses and Skill Enhancement Programme for Personality Development are



conducted to groom each student so that they can excel in their chosen professional field.



## Library

Library is the Gateway to Knowledge that is fundamental for the existence of any sound academic environment and Mewar adheres to this philosophy. Both the Institutes have separate fully computerized libraries for the students at the campus. The Mewar libraries support the Institute's programs of study. They have stock of over 40,000 book titles on all major subjects e.g. Management, Computers, Humanities, Education, Law, Social Sciences etc. Additionally, they have also subscribed to journals and newspapers. There is a wide range of periodicals, quality books on different subjects, a number of reports and Law magazines available in both print and electronic medium. The Library Software used is KOHA. For e-resources they have subscribed to Online Libraries DELNET, NDLI & MANUPATRA.

The collection in the library is constantly enriched with books prescribed by the syllabi and additionally on the suggestions of students and faculty members. The students are encouraged to use the library for extended hours, beyond class timings. A separate section is segregated for reference books that stocks extremely erudite collection. Computers with high speed internet connectivity are available in the Library.

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## Guest Lecturers, Seminars, and Industrial Visits

Mewar organizes specialized national seminars/workshops to orient faculty and students about the latest issues and skill development. Resources from the institutions of high repute, prominent media personalities and journalists, educationist, leading practitioners of law, taxation, public relations, advertising, marketing and many more are invited to speak on the topics as guest lecturers. Workshops for Mental Well being and Yoga too are conducted to maintain a stress free mind. National Seminars on



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relevant issues are conducted by each department to enhance learning amongst all.

Industrial visits re-orient the theoretical knowledge gained in classes with the practical aspects. Students of each department are taken to visit industries, business houses, industrial exhibitions, Courts, Educational Institutes etc to enhance their practical knowledge. Visits to CMC, NIESBUD, Mother Dairy, Parle G, PCRA, Apron Solution Pvt. Ltd., Havells India Ltd., Yakut, Varun Beverages (Pepsi), Coca Cola Happiness Factory are organized for students of Management and Computer Science Departments.

### Value Added Courses

To enable the students to handle the demands of the industry, it is important to supplement the courses of Higher Education with Value Added Courses. Hence, the up skilling of their aptitudes and areas of interest prepare them well for the future. The Institute offers various Value Added Courses including IT, Basic Computer Skills, Language Proficiency, Banking and Legal aspects, Cyber Law & Crime. Certificates are provided on successful completion of the course. These courses are designed as per the requirement of industry and the students emerge confident and well groomed for their Placement rounds post completion.



### Presentation Week and Moot Court

In addition to theory classes, inter-class presentations along with chart preparation and assignments on the topics relevant to the course curriculum are frequently organized for the enhancement of knowledge. Each student is allotted a topic after the completion of each unit to prepare presentations and participate in self learning opportunities. By this participatory method of learning the students not only develop confidence to express themselves without any hesitation but also develop in-depth knowledge of the given topics. At the end of the semester an inter-departmental Presentation Competition is conducted wherein the best presenters of each department compete with each other to exhibit their communication skills.

An excellent Moot Court provides opportunity to the Law students to practice court room procedures. The institute trains the Law students about the procedures and practices of court in simulated situation. There is a verbal argument, similar to an argument made before an appellate court. The argument lasts for around fifteen minutes and during this time the attorney presents an argument and answers questions posed by the panel of judges. It is not a trial: there are no witnesses and no evidences. The arguments are evaluated on the application of the law to the facts of the case.





## Labs at Mewar

Students put their theoretical framework into practical knowledge in Labs so Mewar Institute has arranged this facility for students in an effective manner

### a) Computer Lab and Internet Facilities

It is an important resource for students and faculty members to access and utilize technology for various academic purposes. In order to meet the demands of course curriculum as well as professional requirements, there are four modern air-conditioned Computer Labs. The Labs have more than 200 branded computer systems on the LAN and a range of routine and special software like MS-Office 365, Unix, Oracle, C++, Java, Visual Basic etc. The computer labs have the latest operating systems with 24-hour internet access. We also have a Campus agreement with Microsoft to provide all the latest Microsoft Software at our doorstep. Microsoft Campus agreement covers all Microsoft software including Windows and MS Office.



### b) Biotechnology Lab

Biotechnology lab is well equipped with specialized tools, equipment, and resources for conducting experiments and research. The department has over

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100 Master's in-house projects in the areas of Environmental Biotechnology, Microbial Biotechnology, Phytochemistry, Algal Biotechnology, Nanobiotechnology. The department was awarded with 3 years Government Funded Research Project by CST, Lucknow in the area of Algal Biofuel Production from 15th Feb' 2017 to 14th Feb 2020. The Biotechnology department has also mentored in developing Vermicompost and water-harvesting pit at the Institute campus.



### c) Personality Development Lab and Mirror Room

The PDP Lab is equipped with adequate infrastructure to enhance the skills of the students and groom them as per current professional needs. Presentations, Debates, Group discussions and Mock Interview sessions conducted in these labs boost the confidence and prepare the students for their prospective



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careers. The Mirror Room, an extension of the PDP course, is designed to prepare and observe the basic nuances of body language. Imbibing positive gestures and improving through observing, practicing and learning form a part of this program. The students emerge confident with regaled self esteem by successfully attending these sessions.

## Research and Incubation Centre

- Research is an integral element of all professional courses and there is a Research and Incubation Centre at Mewar where students are assisted by professors and professionals for conducting conclusive research which is needed to pursue their higher studies in the areas of interest. A few noted research of the biotechnology department have been published in the Nature Portfolio, Springer-nature, Elsevier, Royal Society of Chemistry, IOP, and CSIR-NiScPR publications. In 2022-23, the department's faculty members published seven articles in SCIE-indexed (Web of Science)/high-impact journals. Mewar Institute was awarded the ISO 9001 certification in 2023. Mewar Institute of Management was awarded the Certificate of Appreciation by MOE's Innovation Cell at IIC Regional Meet in 2022 at Lucknow for the best creative Poster on Institute's Innovation and Entrepreneurial



Journey. The Incubation Center has tied up with 21 collaborators for internship, field trip, on-the-job training, research and other academic activities. It has organized workshops, Quiz/essay/activities-based competitions and awareness sessions, mentoring sessions, guest lectures, and industrial visits.

## Gandhi Study Center

The Institute promotes the concept of harmony and peace amidst every student to evolve as a citizen of the world. To facilitate personal development by adhering to the principles of education laid down by the Father of the Nation, a specified room has been allocated for Gandhi Studies and is named – Gandhi Study Center. Since Gandhiji believed in skill development of the students in addition to pure academics, his vision is shared with the students. The students are exposed to the concepts of non violence in communication and life. In future this Centre would be home to Gandhi Research.

## Sports

Sports play a significant role in Student's development and its importance extends beyond mere entertainment. Engaging in sports promotes physical fitness and well-being.

Regular participation in sports helps individuals develop strength, stamina, flexibility, and overall physical coordination. It also aids in keeping at bay numerous ailments. Here at Mewar we have dedicated courts for various sports for e.g.: Basket ball, Volley ball courts and Badminton. The campus consists of a recreation room for indoor games like Table Tennis, Chess, Carom and others. We have teams for various sports that regularly participate in various Inter-College competitions. The sports department and



sports teacher is available to encourage and monitor the activities. The Sports teams have brought laurels to college in Basket Ball, Volleyball and Cricket by winning several inter-college sports competitions. A Yoga room encourages students to meditate and instill tranquility amongst them in these stressful times.



## Cafeteria

The hub of attraction for all is the cafeteria of an institute as this is the place where ingenious minds are at their best. The Institute has a cafeteria within the campus which provides a variety of healthy food items, snacks, beverages, lunch at the rates controlled by the Management. The quality of the food is checked on a regular basis by the concerned authorities. The menu is updated and altered time to time to spruce the taste buds of our young learners. The air cooled cafeteria is furnished adequately with separate seating arrangement for students and staff.



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**Counselling Facility:** This is a unique concept that is carried out in Mewar. Counseling of students by their teachers is a pathway that develops a special rapport between student and teacher. One to one interaction between faculty and students helps them to reach out for help and reduce stress in the fast paced world of today. The students converging from diverse backgrounds in the Institute find the counselling system a safe haven wherein they can express themselves and be guided properly.

**Student Council:** An energetic Student Council at Mewar works in close tandem with the faculty in organizing different events of the Institute. Every year Prefects, Class Representatives, Student Council Members, Editorial Board Members, Placement Board Members, Gender Champions are inducted into the Council in an 'Investiture Ceremony' that is organized in a grand manner. Students take an oath to perform the duties diligently towards their respective teams and contribute to the glory of the Institute. They are awarded batches to honor their posts and each Council member becomes a responsible youth who has to participate actively in maintaining a contented and enthusiastic student body.



**NSS:** The Institute has been allotted a unit of 100 students from the University for enrolling in the National Service Scheme. Students register into this scheme with the sole objective to get hands on experience in



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delivering community service and evolve as empathetic citizens of the nation. The NSS team has conducted various campaigns like Medical Aid Camps, Legal Aid Camps, Cleanliness Drives and Cloth distribution drives in slum areas nearby.



### Disciplinary Committees as per UGC norms:

#### a) Anti- Ragging Committee

Anti-Ragging Committee is present to prevent and address the issue of ragging. Ragging in any form is strictly prohibited in Mewar. It is considered a serious offense and strict measures will be taken against the student who will be involved in ragging. A vigilant Anti Ragging Committee keeps check of the implementation of this belief throughout the campus. The Committee also provides a disciplined ambience amongst the students wherein they feel safe and secure. The focus is to foster a healthy relationship amongst the students of different departments. The team comprises of a legal advisor amongst other staff members. The members and the Convener are doing a commendable job in maintaining a closely controlled environment.

#### b) Grievance Redressal Committee

In order to handle the complaints of

students pertaining to the infrastructure or tangible facilities of the Institute the Grievance Redressal Committee of Mewar functions meticulously round the clock. In case any complain or issue needs to be addressed by the Committee members a thorough investigation is carried out and a proper resolution is provided. This ensures an environment wherein the students and staff trust the officials and encourages loyalty amongst all. The committee members and the Convener are thus instrumental in maintaining a harmonious atmosphere in the campus.

#### c) Sexual Harassment and Internal Complaints Committee

This Committee addresses the gender sensitivity issues that arise if a student of any gender is aggrieved. The Committee comprises of members from the faculty along with an external female member from an NGO and to handle complaints lodged by students, members from the student body are also included in the team. They are actively present to gauge the attitude of the students, identifying those who are prone to create disturbance and discipline them. Additionally in case there is any complaint of harassment the committee looks into the issue, counsels the aggrieved party and metes out suitable action. This committee has successfully maintained a healthy equilibrium in the campus amongst all genders.

### Clubs at Mewar

The Institute has 5 clubs to manage the different events effectively. They are; The Cultural Eco Club, Editorial Club, Sports and Wellness Club and SPARDHA (Innovation, Skill Development and Student's Empowerment) Club comprising of members



from the faculty and student body. They organize events related to industry and academia meet, Placement and training events, promote performing and visual arts, green initiatives, health awareness events, publications, cultural and sports events. Apart from these, the Faculty Development Club organizes Faculty Development Programs, Teacher's Day Celebrations.



## Placement and Training Cell

The Placement and Training Cell at Mewar focuses on assisting students in their transition from academics to the professional world. The primary objective of a Placement and Training Cell is to facilitate employment opportunities for students and provide them with the necessary skills and guidance to succeed in their careers. The Cell organizes Campus Recruitments and Internships for the students of different courses.

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**Here are some key functions and responsibilities performed by our Placement and Training Cell:**

- 1. Industry Relations:** The cell establishes and maintains relationships with various industries, organizations, and recruiters to understand their hiring needs and facilitate recruitment processes.
- 2. Campus Recruitment:** The Placement and Training Cell coordinates and manages on-campus recruitment drives, where companies visit the campus to conduct interviews and select candidates for job placements.
- 3. Internship and Training Programs:** They facilitate internships, industrial visits, and training programs for students to gain practical exposure and develop industry-specific skills. This helps students enhance their employability and bridge the gap between theoretical knowledge and practical application.





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## Cultural Activities

The numerous cultural activities at Mewar provide the students opportunities to express themselves, develop confidence and social skills that are essential for their grooming. Considered as a crucial part of their education, a multitude of platforms are made available for students to showcase their talents. The Cultural Club organizes weekly inter departmental competitions in addition to the Annual College Festival – Abhivyakti, Fresher’s Welcome – Parichay and Farewell.

The Music room managed by a dedicated teacher is home to long practice hours for these cultural events. Through celebration of Jayantis of prominent personalities like Maharana Pratap, Swami Vivekananda and



others, the students learn to understand them and present their viewpoint through plays, dances, songs, speeches and poems. The dance troupe of Mewar has won accolades in inter – college competitions. Festivals as Basant Panchami, Holi and Diwali are celebrated with

fervor in the campus and the joyous vibes resonate through the corridors.

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

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
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
